

General Information

Do not mount ceiling/wall fittings onto damp surfaces such as newly painted or plastered areas as this may cause discolouration of the finish.


Tools which may be required:

Small Electrical Slotted Screwdriver


Insulation Tape



Wiring the lamp

Refer to the diagrams below to ensure safe and correct connection to the mains supply.

For Double insulated items (Class 2): These are marked with the symbol



Please use a BS 6220 approved junction box for connecting to supply.

Switch on!

You may now switch the electricity back on at the mains.

Changing the colour temperature.

If you want to change the CCT:

Turn the light off by the wall switch (Not supplied), then turn it back on within 5 second, the CCT will be changed once.

If you don't want to change the CCT: Wait for more than 6 seconds before turning on, the CCT will not be changed.

Reset mode: Reset to 3000K: turn off-turn on 7 times within 10 second, the all lights will be reset to 3000K.
